The children in Y56 will be visiting **Hutton in the Forest** as part of a topic on 'Tudors & Victorians', on Tuesday 22nd **September**. **Hutton in the Forest** is a beautiful historic house on the north eastern edge of the **Lake District**. It is the home of Lord and Lady Inglewood and their children and has belonged to the family since 1605. The house was originally a medieval stronghold and the **Pele Tower** still survives. Succeeding generations have altered and added to the house and both the outside and the inside show a wide range of architectural and decorative styles from the 17<sup>th</sup> century to the present day.

We will leave school at **9.00 am prompt** and return for **3.15 pm**. The children will need a packed lunch (no glass bottles please), and should wear school uniform, comfortable footwear and take a waterproof coat as part of the trip will be exploring the extensive gardens and woodland.
